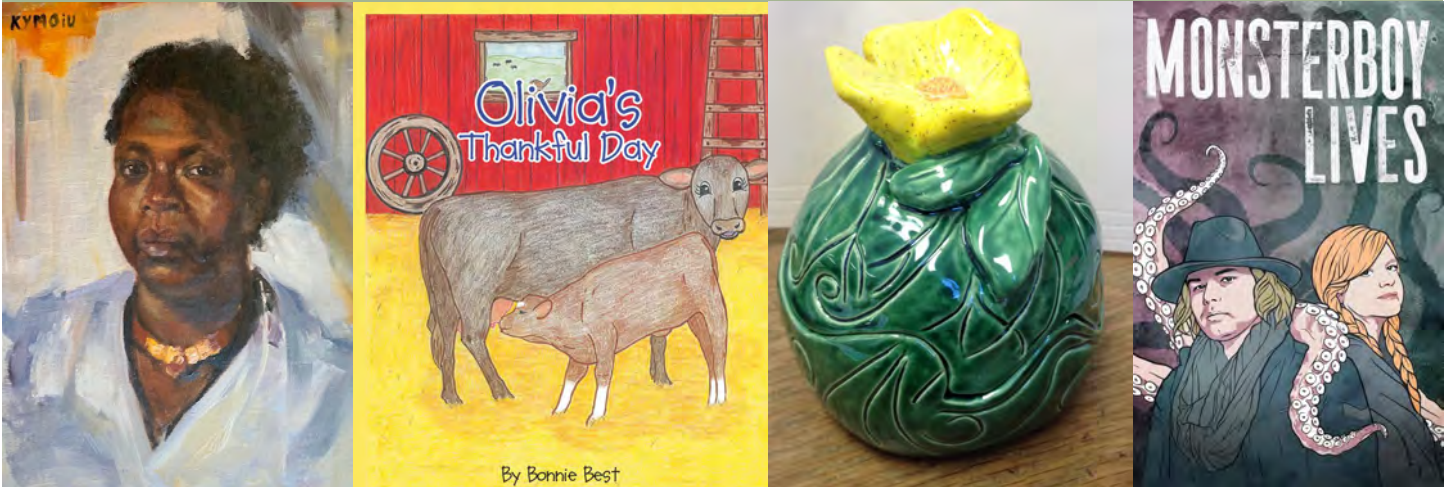

Welcome

Thank you so much for registering for the 13th Annual Delta Arts Festival in downtown Newport, Arkansas to be held on June 3rd and 4th. You are one of over 450 artists who has participated in at least one of our Delta Arts Festivals over the last 13 years.

We will have 200 artists, 40 authors, over 70 musicians, and 10 film screenings in the 2 days. We expect more than 3,000 people to attend the show and who are looking to buy art, literature, listen to great music and watch Arkansas based films.

You help our community by bringing quality art, music, literature, and film to which many people in our region might not otherwise have access. You brighten Newport and northeast Arkansas with your creativity and we want to celebrate that.

We will have around 200 community volunteers who will be on hand to make your visit more fun and profitable. Please reach out to your building managers for anything you might need to help you during your stay.

This book contains information on all for aspects of the festival, the Delta Visual Arts Show, the Delta Festival of Books, the Delta Musicians Showcase, and the Delta Silver Screen Film Fest. We are quickly becoming the largest multi-disciplinary arts event in the state of Arkansas. We have participants this year from Arkansas, California, Florida, Mississippi, Missouri, Tennessee, Texas and from 78 different towns and cities within Arkansas. 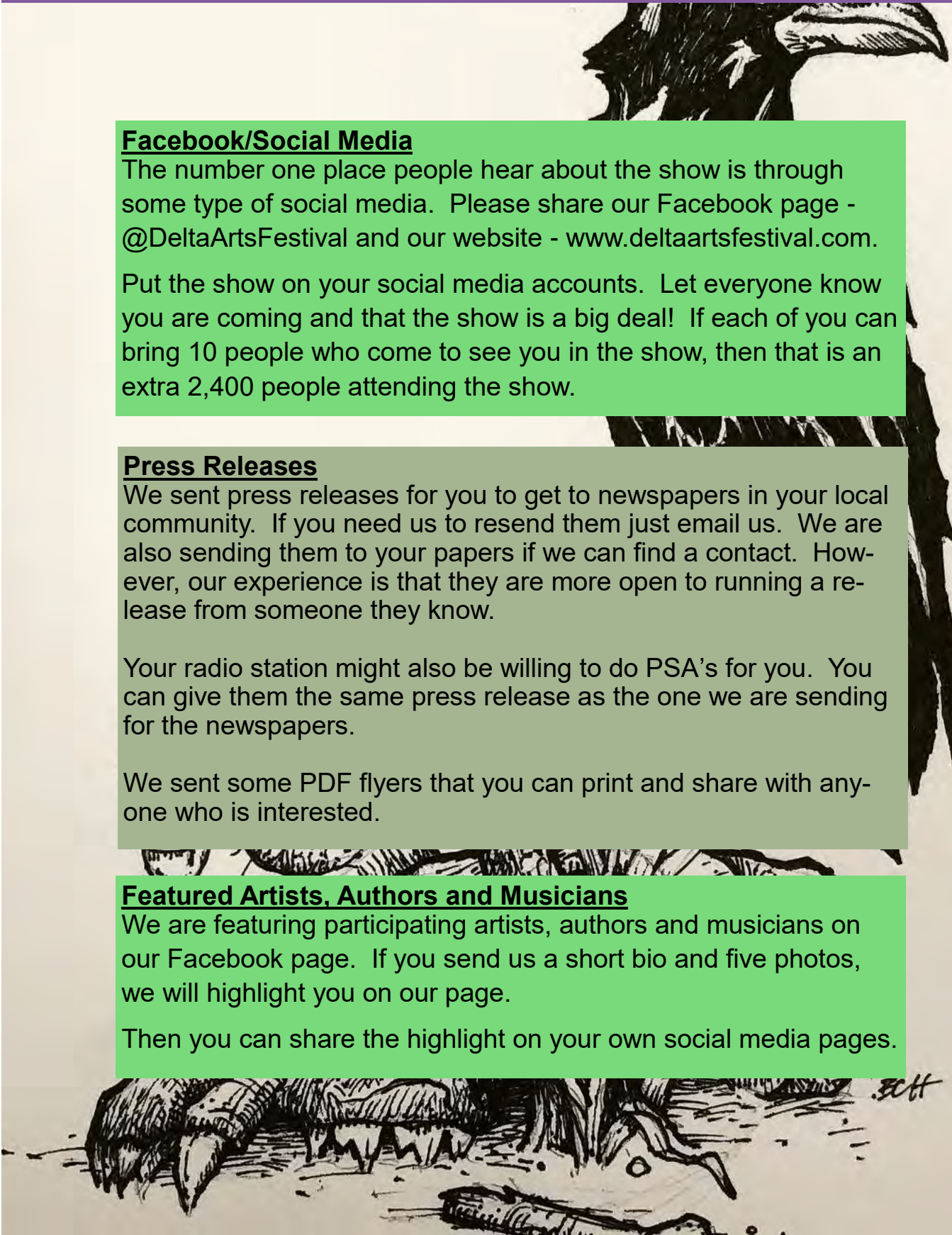
Your radio station might also be willing to do PSA's for you. You can give them the same press release as the one we are sending for the newspapers.

Important Change for Next Year (2023)

Registration

This year we have had a particularly high number of either artists or authors who have registered and then had to cancel for various reasons. While we feel we will be able to fill these spots, the closer it gets to the show, the more we find that people on the waiting list have formed alternate plans for the weekend. We understand the need to cancel and realize that issues will arise. On our end we have to lock in many aspects of the show and are unable to change them within 60 days of the show. These include insurance, press releases, rental tables and chairs, rental tents, food contracts, etc. Because of these factors we will be instituting a refundable reservation deposit for booth spaces.

You will pay the deposit when you reserve your booth for the next year. That can be during the current festival or afterward. If you attend the festival in 2023, your deposit will be refunded to you in full at the festival. If you cancel prior to April 1, 2023, then we will mail you a complete refund of your deposit. If you cancel after April 1, 2023, then you will forfeit your deposit and it will be used toward festival expenses.

If you are a no show at the festival and have not let us know that you will not be coming you will both forfeit your deposit and your deposit amount should you register for a future festival will double.

Financial Matters for Artist, Authors & Musicians

Pay It Forward Donations

Voluntary donations by cash or check will gladly be accepted to help defray the cost of the festival. We will provide you with an envelope on Saturday and you can make a voluntary donation based on how you did during the festival. This is not required. Every single dollar donated is applied to the next year's festival. We are a non-profit so we can provide a tax receipt should you need one.

Sales Taxes

We are required by the state to provide you with a sales tax form and envelope. As an artist you are required to pay state and local sales taxes on your sales by submitting the form within 30 days of the show. The Arkansas Department of Finance Administration prefers that you pay by putting a check in the provided envelope and returning it to us. If you do that, we will submit the payment to the state. If you have an Arkansas Sales Tax number, then you can submit your sales on your regular report. Ultimately, you are responsible for paying taxes on your sales at the festival. If we can assist, please let us know.

The sales tax codes and amounts are as follows:

State of Arkansas - 6.5%

Newport (Code 34-01) - 1.5%

Jackson County (Code 34-00) - 2.25%

The total sales tax for downtown Newport is 10.25%. You can choose to price your work "tax included" or you can add 10.25% on to the price at the time of the sale. Whichever way works for you is fine with us.

Any questions relating to the Arkansas Sales and Use Tax should be referred to the Arkansas Department of Finance Administration.

A piece of gold ribbon will be in your Delta Arts Festival packet when you arrive at the festival. To participate in the Delta Artist Contest, please attach the gold ribbon to the piece of art you would like the judges to consider. Make sure to place the ribbon and the piece of art where it can easily be seen by the judges when they come through your building or tent. This needs to be placed on the piece on Friday.

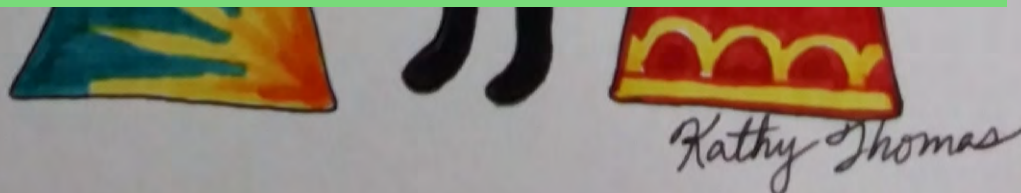
The judges will come through on Saturday and award a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbon in each visual art venue. The judges will then select a “Best of Show” from the ten first place winners. After the judging is complete, the building or tent managers will come through and place ribbons on the winning pieces and take a photo with each winner.

Winners may be from any medium or style of visual art (painting, sculpture, photography, jewelry, pottery, craft, etc.). Winners will be announced publicly on the Delta Arts Festival Facebook page the week after the festival.

The judges have an art background and are volunteering their time. Their decisions are final and will not be altered.

If you do not wish to participate in the art contest, then do not place your gold ribbon on any of your artwork and it will not be evaluated by the judges.

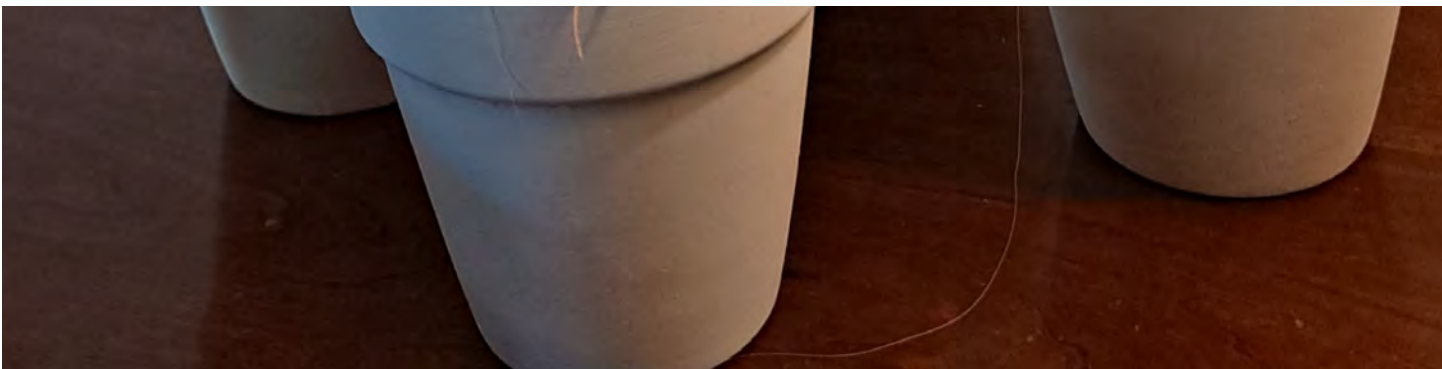

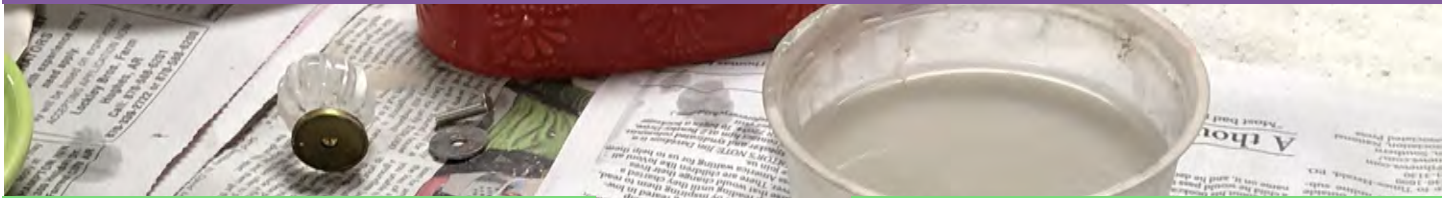
